What's happening in Des Moines?

Des Moines Parks System Gets National Attention • Recently released by the Trust for Public Land's (TPL), the City of Des Moines park system is now ranked the 25th best system in the country, up from 35th in 2021. Des Moines soared above other cities such as Atlanta, San Diego, Tampa and Omaha due to the continued investment in our parks by the City and partners, such as the new restrooms at Witmer Park, a new playground at Riverview Park and six new basketball hoops at Weeks Middle School Park.

The City Welcomes More Accessory Housing - As part of a strategy to increase affordable housing opportunities in the City of Des Moines, earlier this month City Council approved changes to the zoning code that makes it easier for homeowners to develop accessory household units (AHUs). Also known as "accessory dwelling units (ADUs)" or "guest houses," accessory household units were added to the City of Des Moines' zoning, planning and design codes during a comprehensive update in 2019.

Mitzi Bolaños Anderson Starts as Des Moines Civil and Human Rights Director • The City of Des Moines recently announced the hiring of Mitzi Bolaños Anderson as director of the Civil and Human Rights Department. Anderson joins the City from Anchorage, Alaska, where she served as the executive director of the Anchorage Equal Rights Commission since 2019.

Additional updates

Construction on 63rd • City of Des Moines staff have worked with the lowa DOT, City of West Des Moines, and private developers to plan and start construction of a 10-feet wide shared use trail along 63rd Street (also known as lowa Highway 28 and SE 1st Street in West Des Moines) between the Levee Trail (north of the Raccoon River) and SW McKinley Avenue (also location of Veterans Parkway Trail). MoveDSM identifies 63rd Street as part of the future bike network, and the Southwest Infrastructure Planning Study also identifies the need for the facility. As one of the few locations for crossing the Raccoon River west of downtown, this is an opportunity to ensure safe access across one of the biggest transportation barriers in the community for people not traveling in a motor vehicle. news.iowadot.gov
