The Des Moines Parks and Recreation Program Guide got a makeover and a rebranding. What was once known as the "program" guide is now an "activities" guide, presenting seasonal activities available for

Future Reichardt Community Recreation Center



The future Reichardt Community Recreation Center has achieved its final round of fundraising, marking a critical milestone for the project. The Des Moines City Council approved another \$900,000 in donations on August 21, including a naming agreement for the center to be located at the Grubb Family YMCA site. This \$6M fundraising success propels the project forward.

The City's commitment of \$12M over four years for the \$18M project, slated to open in 2026, aligns with substantial fundraising efforts totaling \$6.22M. Notable recent donations include \$1M from MidAmerican Energy and \$1.2M from The Reichardt Family, along with various naming designations for facility components.
