#### City Announces New Online Platform to Modernize Planning and Zoning for Businesses and Residents

City staff recently developed a userfriendly web-based platform, powered by enCodePlus, to streamline planning and zoning ordinances, addressing concerns raised by small business owners and those unfamiliar with the processes. Chapters **134 and 135** are now fully digital, providing quick access for anyone looking to make improvements or build in Des Moines. The platform includes GIS maps, a signage calculator, and regulations by specific districts.

"This platform is an important evolution for City staff and the public," said Planning and Urban Design Administrator Jason Van Essen.

Applicants can access the platform through links on the website's <u>Development</u> <u>Services section</u> and all future documents mailed to applicants.



#### Explore the Downtown Skywalk by Participating in the 2024 Treesure Hunt!

Adventure through the City's iconic Skywalk as you take part in The 2024 Treesure Hunt which kicked off on January 16, featuring seven Forestry-themed art installations painted on the windows of the Skywalk system.
